

Polphine Adventures



This tour will take you to the earlier capital of the Island (KIZIMKAZI) where traces of an old Shirazi settlement (probably a fort) may be seen in an enclosure surrounded by a wall near the seashore. Near the walled enclosure is an ANCIENT MOSQUE where an inscription records that the mosque was built in A.H.500 (A.D 1107) by a Sheikh Seyyid Abi Amran, who appears to have been a local ruler. You will then proceed to a small fishing village where you will be taken for a boat ride in a motorized local boat in search of dolphins (85% chances). You will also get the chance to go snorkeling and see some of the beautiful sea life around Zanzibar.



Tour of the historical stone town (city tour):



This introductory guided tour of Zanzibar provides living evidence of a rich culture heritage, where arab, India, Persian and European influences blended with local African tradition. Historic buildings with elaborately carved wooden doors shaded by balconies, loggias and verandas line the narrow winding streets. The tour includes a visit to town market, slave market, house of wonders, sultan palace, national museum, etc. you will also have about 30 minutes of shopping.

Spice tour:





This guided tour offers a look at small farms in the rural area that grow cloves, vanilla ,nutmeg, cardamom and other spice ,medicinal and ornamental plants, and tropical fruits. this tour provides a rare experience to prove why Zanzibar is referred to as the "spice island". it also includes a visit to the Persian baths build in 1850 by Seyyid Said Sultan (first sultan of Zanzibar) for his wife princes sheh Zard (grand-daughter of Fattah Ali shah of Persian).

Sunset cruises:

Trace the journey of the princess Sayyida in traditional Arabian dhow. Set forth from stone town and sail along the shores of this historic coast, while the sun sinks into the ocean painting the town orange and gold. The crew will ply you with tales and wine, while you soak up the ambiance once enjoyed by Arabian royalty.

Prison Island

This tour includes a visit to the historic Prison Island with its giant land tortoise. The island was formerly owned by an Arab and used for confinement of refractory slaves. It was bought by General Mathews and the jail (goal) which still stands was built in 1893 and hence the name "PRISON ISLAND". While on the Island you will be able to swim, sunbathe and snorkel.





This guided tour will take you to Jozani natural forest, the smaller trees and shrubs make several sub-canopies under the highest canopy. Walking through the nature trail of the forest is a habitat for many species of animals, and birds. It is famous for its Red Colobus Monkey, the rare species. The Zanzibar RED COLOBUS has been isolated from its mainland counterparts for at least ten to fifteen thousand years, thus producing distinct sub-species with different calls, eating habits and coat patterns. Jozani Forest has become the last stronghold in the world for this particular type of colobus.
